We are pleased to inform you that your paper, "A *real-time compensation method for MV voltage transducer for power quality analysis*" by Gabriella Crotti, Daniele Gallo, Domenico Giordano, Carmine Landi, Mario Luiso, presented in the XX IMEKO TC-4 Symposium in Barcelona, has been recommended by the TC4 Board for publication in the Special Issue of ACTA IMEKO.

You are therefore invited to provide an updated and extended version, with namely:

- modified title to distinguish the extended paper from the original Symposium paper.
- extended to remove size limitations the Symposium required for its proceedings.
- updated to take into account progress since the Symposium submission and discussions at the Symposium.

Note that, all the extended papers will undergo a normal revision process.

Authors are requested to submit, in the cover letter, a list of modifications and improvements of the original paper that have been done. In order to simplify and speed up the work of the reviewers, the paper should be formatted in accordance with a unified template specific for ACTA IMEKO which you will find attached to this email. Note that, the manuscript must include a reasonable amount of references to previously published work from other research groups within the same topic. For example, the average number of references in Measurement from Elsevier for 2010 was 19.4.

The deadline for submission of the extended paper is December 16th

To make sure that the special issue is completed on time, **please send us a quick email (deadline October 2nd) indicating that you have received this invitation and that you plan to submit the extended paper for publication in the special issue.** Further instructions regarding the submission process and the template will be sent after we receive confirmation of intended submission.
